



- Present Progressive to talk about actions at the moment of speaking . (“¿Qué estás haciendo?”) – What are you doing?
- Past Progressive to talk about the course of an action in the past. (“¿Qué estabas haciendo?”) – What were you doing?
- Past Progressive & Simple Past to talk about an action in progress in the past, interrupted by another in the past. “Estaba estudiando cuando/ mientras...) – I was studying when –
- Pretérito Imperfecto -aba, ía.
- Present Perfect to talk about experiences. (“Has estado en...?”) – Have you been ...?
- Future (Will & Going to...) Voy a ir.... // Iré
