Team Registration:

There will be a single High School division during this tournament, but Varsity Middle Schoolers are welcome. As long as your school can provide a judge for the entirety of the tournament for every five debaters (the equivalent of one team) in the competition, we will not limit the amount of teams you can bring, however, we only have space for 40 teams overall (200 students) meaning that we will take registration on a first-come, first-serve basis. We will cap the tournament at an even number of teams to avoid any tabulation conflicts. Only institutional teams with a faculty advisor/coach can register. All teams must have 5 members. If your registration is larger than 3 teams please contact me directly, but still fill out the form. Each faculty advisor is responsible for their teams.
