Carlos is Vice-President for Regulatory Policy at the National Banking and Securities Commission (CNBV). He is in charge of the following areas: Regulatory Development, Economic Studies, International Affairs and Access to Financial Services.

He is also the Executive Secretary of the National Council of Financial Inclusion and a member of the Board of the CNBV; he serves as a member of the Basel Committee on Banking Supervision and participates in several working groups sponsored by multilateral financial organizations.

Recently, he actively participated in the design of a project law aimed at regulating financial technology-related institutions (the FinTech Law). In this regard, he will also be responsible for the design of secondary regulation projects stem from the Fintech Law.
